- Campfire activities

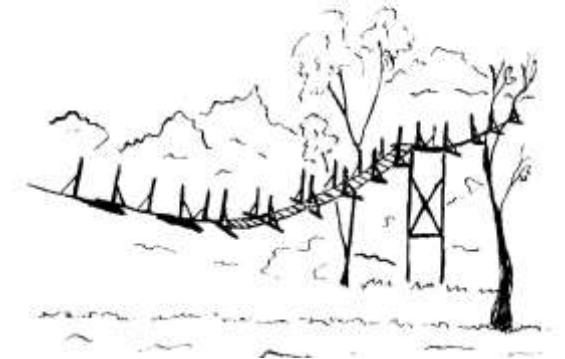
